- ▶ Tutored **100** school aged children in the homework Help Program.
- ▶ Served over **500** meals to children enrolled in the Summer Meal Program in 2007.
- ▶ Created Thanksgiving Baskets for **97** children and **58** adults and helped **291** children through our "Adopt-A-Child" Holiday Assistance Program.
- ▶ Worked the Teen Talk phone center weekdays from 3 to 8 pm, providing over **1800** hours of service.
- ▶ Provided for and comforted **85** youth who were sheltered at The Runaway and Homeless Youth Shelter in 2007.
- ▶ Gathered food for **225** people from the surrounding Towns who came to the food pantry for help.

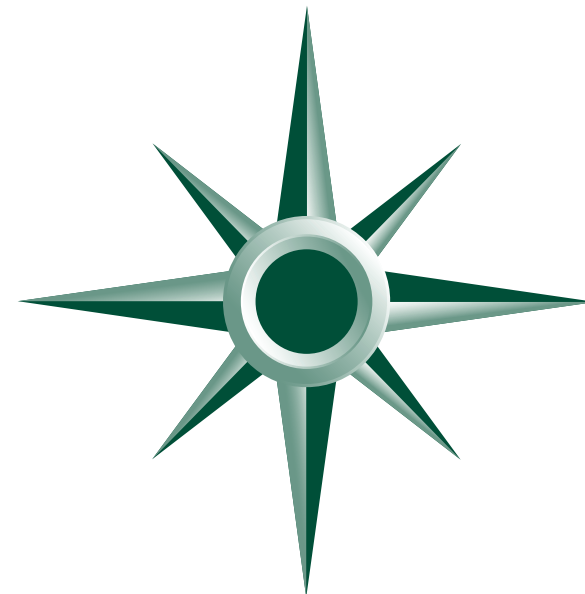

THE PROGRAMS OF CAPTAIN YOUTH AND FAMILY SERVICES...

▶ OUTREACH IN THE PARK AT CHERYL'S LODGE:

Is a community center that offers enrichment programming for children and their families. Activities and services at the Lodge provide safety and education as a means to empower personal success.

▶ TEEN ACTIVITY BOARD:

Has had over 1000 high-school members. Visits to senior centers and children's hospitals, community cleanups, and various fundraisers are just some of the projects that translate into teaching teens the importance of community service and leadership.

▶ FAMILY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM:

Matches volunteer mentors with families in crisis to provide support, resources and training. Mentors help families recognize their strengths as well as opportunities available to them. Together they set goals that pave the way towards self-reliance.

▶ FAMILY ASSISTANCE:

Brings together funding for emergency financial assistance for such basic needs as rent, food, utilities and healthcare. This is made possible through the generosity of members of the community, faith-based groups, and civic groups.

▶ TEEN TALK:

Our confidential helpline, is staffed by over fifty trained youth. Teen Talk provides guidance to teens who may be experiencing trouble at home, academic and peer pressures, or who are challenged with drugs and alcohol.

▶ CAPTAIN'S TREASURES:

Provides quality used clothing, furniture and household goods at great savings. Volunteers help operate the store and proceeds go to support CAPTAIN programs. Additionally, we donate thousands of dollars in clothing and furniture to our deserving neighbors.

▶ JOB ASSIST:

Offers teens employment readiness and job placement by matching them with a variety of employers and job opportunities.

▶ RUNAWAY AND HOMELESS YOUTH SHELTER:

Provides at risk youth with safe, emergency shelter for up to thirty days. Case management, tutoring and mediation services are provided to help youth resolve their issues and reunite with their families.
